Discussion included the applicant's plan to use the existing drive-thru lane configuration. Commissioner Rios commented on the existing concrete island in the drive-thru lane that he believed lacked visibility. Commissioner Wightman added the island is a stacking lane requirement to separate the drive-thru lane traffic from the rest of the vehicle traffic traveling on-site. The purpose is to keep the drive-thru lane traffic herded and let other vehicles go around. Chair Michel stated if visibility measures are required, it should and can be handled at the Staff level. The Staff present concurred. There being no further discussion, Chair Michel invited a motion.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wightman, second by Commissioner Wade, to recommend approval of this item as written.

Motion to recommend approval carried unanimously by those present.
